- **Confidential Paper Shredding** - Bring your boxes of paper to be shredded safely and securely.
- **Hazardous Waste Drop-Off** - Drop off oil-based paints, varnish, harsh cleaning supplies, herbicides and pesticides, etc. Let us help you get rid of those environmentally unfriendly items in an environmentally friendly manner.
- **Rx Drug Drop Box** - Bring your unused, unwanted, or expired prescription drugs to be placed in the secure drop box that is located in the Police Department lobby.
- **Recycle, Recycle, Recycle** - Bring old cell phones, computers and other electronics, and car and lawn mower batteries for safe disposal. Drop off heavy scrap metal, aluminum and tires for recycling as well.
- **Proper Paint Disposal** - Latex (water-based) paint is not a hazardous waste and WILL NOT be accepted at Greening the Hills. Only oil-based paints (Alkyd) will be accepted.
- **Simple Recycling** - a representative will be in attendance to discuss with our residents, this new "soft recycling" program that the Village will soon be implementing.
- **Cleveland Food Bank Donations** - the Service Department is sponsoring a Food-Drive at this event to benefit the Cleveland Food Bank, so please bring non-perishable food items to donate when you come in.
- **Goodwill** - the Service Department will also be accepting donations for Goodwill, so bring any unwanted gently-used clothing and/or household items to donate.
