Updates from Mayor Spencer:

We received favorable feedback from last year's attendees on the silent auction. It was suggested we expand the scope of the auction. Mrs. Sitzwohl will contact Mrs. Hardin-Levine to assist with soliciting items for the auction.

Providing music after the 5K was suggested.

Mr. Misterka reported that he has a food truck contact.

Fundraising and promotion remain the biggest tasks.

The current balance of funds generated by the Head for the Hills event is \$12,294.43

More in the Hills:

Other topic ideas for the events are Rain Gardens and Environmental History of Northeast Ohio.

Open Discussion:
